

Uniform Policy

2023

Students are expected to wear their full School uniform, including blazers and hats when travelling to and from school each day, except on Sport and PE/PASS Days.

Being in incorrect uniform on a particular day will result in a demerit being issued.

Below is a summary of the **School Uniform Policy**. Failure to comply with the Uniform Policy will result in consequences outlined below:

Formal School Uniform

Bags

ASG school bag is the only school bag permitted. ASG Excursion bags and sports bags are the only bags to be taken to excursions or sport. (These items can be purchsed from the uniform shop.)

Belt

Only the ASG School belt is permitted. (This can be purched from the uniform shop.)

Blazer and hat

To be worn to and from school daily, except on Sports Day.

Day Hat

PK-6 students are required to have a day hat daily.

Girls Tunic / Skirt The length of the tunic or skirt must cover the knee, not at or above the knee.

Scarf

Only the ASG scarf is acceptable. (This can be purchased from the uniform shop.)

Shoes

Must be leather, laced and black in colour, with low heels. Primary students are permitted to wear school shoes with buckles or velcro.

Socks

Only ASG socks are permitted. (Please note white socks are not part of our uniform.)

Sport Uniform

House Polo Shirt

All students are expected to wear their house colour Polo Shirt.

Jacket

ASG school sport jacket only. No representative sport jackets, jumpers are to be worn as sport uniform.

Polo Shirt

ASG white polo shirt to be worn underneath the tracksuit. No representative sport jerseys or polo shirts are to be worn as sport uniform. Invisible undergarments are permitted.

Socks

ASG sport socks only.

Sport Shoes

Sport shoes should be predominately white, with white shoelaces. No slip on or ankle high sport shoes are permitted.

Swimwear

Only ASG Swimmwear is permitted.

Tracksuit/Shorts

ASG navy tracksuit pants or shorts only. No other shorts or tracksuit pants (including representative sport pants) are permitted.

All uniform items must be purchased from the All Saints Grammar Uniform Shop.

Jewellery

Boys Only permitted to wear a watch and/or a cross.

No earrings or other piercings permitted.

Girls Only permitted to wear a watch and/or a cross.

One set of earrings (small basic gold or silver studs) only. No other piercings permitted. Please note gems, stones or designer branded earrings are not permitted, no sleepers.

Bangles, anklets, rings are not permitted.

Grooming

Hair

Boys Hair must be clean and tidy. Haircuts must be blended in all around, i.e short back and sides, with an appropriate length at the top.

Crew cuts, steps, undercuts, mohawks, mullets, coloured hair, hair tied back or excessive gel/ wax is unacceptable.

Girls Hair must be tidy, off the face and tied back with a elastic and a **school ribbon**. No headbands, hairclips, scrunchies etc are permitted.

No accessories that are not part of the uniform are permitted

Streaking and other forms of hair colouring are unacceptable.

Make up

Makeup/fake tan is not permitted.

False eye lashes are not permitted.

Nails

Fingernails should be kept short. No nail polish is permitted.

False, acrylic nails, shellac or similar are not to be worn.

Students will be asked to go home.

Beanies are not part of the school uniform and are not permitted to be worn at School.

Shaving

Boys must attend clean shaven and will be offered a razor and shaving cream if necessary, prior to being admitted to class.

Consequences

If students fail to comply with the All Saints Grammar Uniform Policy, the following will apply:

Warning 1: Issued by Mentor/Classroom teacher

Students will be issued with a warning in their school diary PK-6, or via SENTRAL (7-12) which must be signed and/or acknowledged by the parent via the school diary or email. Students must rectify the specified uniform issue by the next school day.

Warning 2: Demerit

Students who fail to rectify the specified uniform issue will be issued with a demerit.

Warning 3: Demerit

Students who fail to rectify the specified uniform issue will be issued with a 2^{nd} demerit.

Warning 4: Demerit

Students who fail to rectify the specified uniform issue will be issued with a 3rd demerit.

Warning 5: Friday Afternoon Detention 3.30-5.00pm

Important Note: Any student who fails to adhere to the above uniform guidelines and reach the after school detention stage and breaches the uniform policy again will be required to attend a formal meeting with the Head of Campus and their parents.

The demerits will be wiped at the end of each term.

Continued breaches will result in a formal meeting with the Head of School.
